St Mary of the Cross

St Mary of the Cross is Australia's first saint. Known as Mary McKillop, she made her first visit by ship to New Zealand in 1894-95.

Mary followed her first visit with three further extended trips. In 1897 she stayed for some time with the sisters in Arrowtown.


