

CARING FOR OUR COMMON HOME

Household cleaning – avoiding the toxins on our floors:

Natural Citrus floor cleaner: Fill bucket with approx. * 4 litres hot water; add * 2 Tb spoons Liquid castile soap; * 10 drops of both orange essential oil and lemon essential oil (or 4 Tb spoons of lemon juice), mix with mop and add * 1 Tb spoon of baking soda.

When it comes to cleaning, lemon is one of the best ingredients. (White vinegar, B soda and water also leave clean, shiny floors).

Washing soda and white vinegar for cleaning purposes are available in the cleaning areas of supermarkets.


